

## **SUTTON & DISTRICT BADMINTON LEAGUE**

### Rules for the Hybrid Division

The introduction of the Hybrid division is primarily aimed at those clubs who might find it difficult to put out a full mixed team in the normal divisions. It is open to all clubs but it is hoped that larger and stronger clubs would be using it for their lesser experienced players.

Each team will play home and away matches against the other teams.

Each team will consist of 4 men and 2 ladies. Each member of the team will be numbered where possible in order of strength before the start of the match.

The order of play should be as indicated on the score cards although where necessary it can be changed provided both captains agree.

Each rubber will consist of two games to 15 with setting at 14 all.

The result will be based on the number of games won and the winning team will be responsible for sending in the result card. In the event of a draw the home side will send in the result card.

The Hybrid division is considered a separate competition to the mixed, mens and ladies competitions and as such players may play for different clubs in those other competitions.
